Motion by Mr. Scherer, second by Mr. Eging to pay the above mentioned bills totaling \$5,554.39. Roll call vote, all yes. Council received the bank reconciliation for the month of February, 2015 showing a balance of \$88,694.56. Mrs. Petkosek furnished a list of the purchase orders for this year numbering 1-2015 through 13-2015 including carryover purchase orders 5-2014 and 38-2014.

HEALTH DISTRICT

The Village received a letter from the Health District regarding new sewage treatment system rules, specifically regarding the placement of a drain outlet within a right-of-way. Council was unsure what the district is asking of the Village. Mrs. Petkosek will contact them to see what we must do.

PORTABLE RESTROOMS

Mayor Wolfe will verify when t-ball starts. If not until May we will not order port-o-let until then.

ROADS

Mike Ferrell knocked the snow down on the Kern property. Mayor Wolfe attended the Claridon Township meeting. Extra hour cost was not included in this year's contract for snow removal. Their current cost is \$65.00 per hr. with a minimum of 4 hours. We will need to make sure that is included in next year's contract. We will also include in our fall newsletter that residents should not plow their snow across the road.

Scrap tire grant that we apply for in conjunction with Claridon no longer reimburses for labor. It is limited to paying for the disposal of tires only.

MISCELLANEOUS

Mr. Eging did not find an ordinance specifically mentioning pit bulls in the village. The ordinance states it is illegal to have a vicious dog in the village.

Libby Savo and Julie Fleckenstein were unable to confirm their water safety day with the fire department so they have postponed until a later date.

There being no further business to come before Council at this time motion by Mrs. Mitchell, second by Mr. Eging to adjourn the meeting at 7:55 p.m.
