

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-6

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF AQUILLA VILLAGE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CLARIDON TOWNSHIP, FOR SNOW PLOWING ON VILLAGE STREETS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF AQUILLA, STATE OF OHIO, THAT


SECTION 1: Claridon Township. has submitted a bid to perform snow plowing of streets and other related services for the Village of Aquilla for the 2014-2015 winter season in the amount of Ten Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and no cents,(\$10,500.00). The Village Council accepts this proposal. The Mayor be and is hereby directed to enter into contract with Claridon township. in an amount not to exceed Ten Thousand Five Hundred Dollars to plow the Village streets during the 2014-2015 winter season, and being in the best interest of the Village of Aquilla.


SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and the all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: This ordinance constitutes an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Aquilla. To keep the Village streets free of accumulations of snow, and for the preservation of Village property; and for further reason that council wishes to authorize the contract at the earliest possible date, this be effective upon its passage.
