

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-4 R

A RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY FOR THE ASSESSMENT OF STREET LIGHTING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Aquilla, Ohio that:

SECTION 1. Council does hereby find that an assessment for Street Lighting is necessary to pay the supplier of electric power, for the improvement of all parcels of land located within the boundaries of the Village of Aquilla, Ohio.

SECTION 2. The total cost of such assessment is on file with the Fiscal Officer for the Village of Aquilla, Ohio constituting the amount of charges levied upon the Village by the supplier of electric power.

SECTION 3. There shall be levied and assessed upon all the lots and lands in the Village of Aquilla, which lots and lands are all specifically benefited by street lighting, a proportionate amount heretofore reported to the Council of said Village by the Fiscal Officer, which assessments and the description of said lots and lands assessed are now on file in the office of the Fiscal Officer for Village of Aquilla and which assessments total Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000.00) per year for each of the two (2) years following the date of this resolution.

All lots and lands currently exempt from payment of real estate taxes are hereby declared to be exempt from the special assessment. The Geauga County Auditor and/ or Treasurer are hereby directed to remit any amounts collected hereunder to the owners of the exempt lots or lands.

SECTION 4. The remainder of the entire cost of electrical power shall be paid out of the General Fund of the Village of Aquilla.

SECTION 5. The assessment charge against each lot or parcel of land shall be certified by the County Auditor, as provided by law, to be placed upon the tax duplicate and collected as other taxes.


SECTION 6. The Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to deliver a certified copy of this resolution to the Geauga County Auditor for process and levy.

SECTION 7. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized pursuant to Section 727.14 of the Ohio Revised Code therein to notify property owners of the assessment by the procedure set forth.

SECTION 8. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 9. This resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and welfare, and for the further reason that the Village is without funds to provide for lighting its streets, this resolution shall be in effective upon its passage.
