

Resolution No. 2016-7 R

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Aquilla has determined that it is necessary to levy a tax outside of the ten mill limitations, for the purpose of a renewal levy of four mill for the purpose of raising additional funds for current expenses of the Village of Aquilla for five years.

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 5705.03 (B) of the Ohio Revised Code, the Council of the Village of Aquilla, Ohio hereby certifies this resolution to the Geauga County Auditor, and requests that the County Auditor certify back to the Village Council the total current tax valuation of the subdivision, and the number of mills required be generated by a specified number of revenue, or the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a specified number of mills, for the purpose of a renewal levy in the amount of four mills for the purpose of raising additional funds for current expenses for five years. Section 5705.19 (A) O.R.C.

Councilman Eging moved for the adoption for the foregoing, and Councilwoman Bennington second the motion. Upon the call of the question, the vote was as follows:




