

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-8R

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Rev. Code Sec. 5705.19, .191, .194, .21, .26

The Council of the Village of Aquilla, Geauga County, Ohio, met in regular/special session on the 14th day of June, 2016, in the Village Hall with the following members present:

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Village of Aquilla, Geauga County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Council passed Resolution 2016-7R on May 10, 2016, finding that it is necessary to levy a tax of four mills outside the ten mill limitation to raise an additional four mills for current operating expenses for five years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Aquilla, Geauga County, Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that:


Section 1. It is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of the Village of Aquilla for the purpose of raising additional funds for current municipal expenses. Therefore, pursuant to §5705.19(A) of O.R.C. at a rate not exceeding 4 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 40 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five years and which levy is a renewal of an existing levy of 4 mills for current municipal expenses.

Section 2. The question of levying additional taxes shall be submitted to the electors of the Village of Aquilla at the general election to be held at the usual voting places within the Village of Aquilla on the 1st day of November, 2016.


Section 3. The levy shall be placed upon the tax list of the current year, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

Section 4. The Fiscal Officer of the Village of Aquilla, Ohio be and he is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections, Geauga County, Ohio. This Resolution is to be passed and certified to the Board of Elections not less than 90 days before the election upon which it will be voted and to notify the Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying the tax to be given as required by law.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law,


